I was hoping you could please send me the number of internal sexual harassment complaints the DHB has received in the last 5 years? (by internal staff members who have complained to the Wairarapa DHB about sexual harassment from either staff members or patients at work.)

If you did receive complaints, did any of them result in disciplinary action?

What processes are in place to deal with those complaints?

Response:

The information you have requested is below.

There have been no cases of sexual harassment complaints in the last 5 years.

Should a staff member complain about a sexual harassment event, the process is to log it on our DHB SQUARE event process software and it would be investigated as per our DHB Investigating Incidents and Occurrences Policy. If required the matter may also be referred through to the police.
